


« THE LAST MISSION » 11 Juillet 1944







Crew of B-24 shot down July 11, 1944.

Lt. Felbinger, the navigator, was killed in bail-out (chute did not open).

Three additional men were on the plane (Names unknown). They were a command pilot and two radar specialists added to the regular crew as the plane was leading a formation on a "Mickey" mission.
